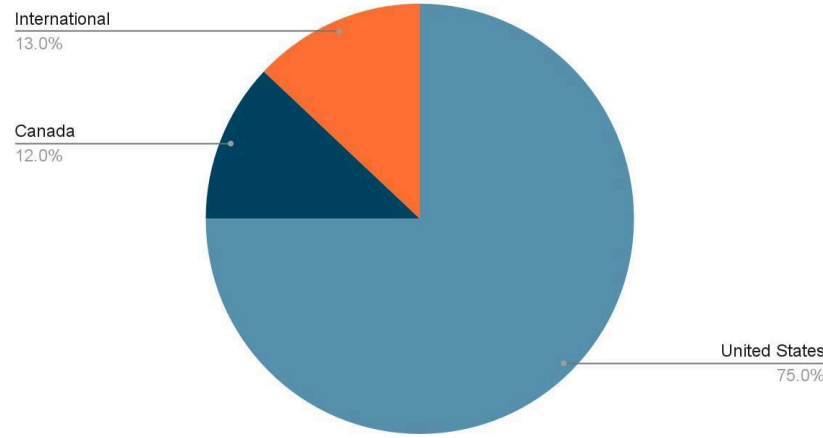

What positions do PDI-POA members hold in their organizations?

Members of PDI-POA are decision makers who purchase gifts, goods, and services. Some work in a single person office. Others are part of extensive protocol teams influencing every decision made at their events, visits, and ceremonies.
